

# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade School Supply List

Just as in fifth grade, 6<sup>th</sup> graders change classrooms for different subjects, so it is important that all students are able to keep their materials in one, organized system for quick and easy access. Students will receive a planner/assignment book on the first day of school.

**All students should bring the following supplies to school on August 31<sup>st</sup>:**

- 1 three-ring binder (2-3" canvas works best)  
OR  
expanding poly file folder (26 file slot with handle is recommended)
- 3 composition notebooks
- 1 three-subject notebook (poly covers are recommended)
- 1 two-subject notebook with pockets (poly covers are recommended)
- 9 two-pocket folders (plastic folders tend to hold up better and last the entire year)
- 1 flat pencil case containing: pencils, an eraser, a highlighter, a blue/black ink pen, a dry-erase marker, a black sharpie, and small pencil sharpener
- 1 French dictionary (*Universal Dictionary-French* by Langenscheidt Pub., Inc. recommended)
- 1 Latin dictionary (*Collins-Gem Latin Dictionary [mini]* by HaperCollins Publishers recommended)
- 1 *Math Dictionary for Kids* by Theresa Fitzgerald (ISBN: 9781593631604)

**Please bring the following supplies to contribute to the classroom community:**

**Students with last names A-K please bring:**

- 1 – package of Clorox or Lysol wipes
- 1 – package of paper towels
- 2 – boxes of tissues
- 2 – packages of wide ruled, loose-leaf notebook paper

**Students with last names L-Z please bring:**

- 1 – package of Clorox or Lysol wipes
- 1 – hand sanitizer
- 2 – boxes of tissues
- 2 – packages of wide ruled, loose-leaf notebook paper

**All students should have access to the following supplies at home:**

- Reference materials: calculator, dictionary, atlas, internet
- A lifetime supply of pencils (to replenish pencil case as needed)
- Art supplies: crayons, colored pencils, markers
- Loose leaf paper
- Spiral bound index cards for making study guides

*All supplies should be replenished through-out the year, as needed.*
