

## Room 2, Supplies your child will need



- Your child will **not** need a "back to school folder" as I will provide this.
- A backpack or something to carry papers, clothing, etc.
- An extra snack for the afternoon at the beginning of the school year. This could be a half sandwich or a piece of fruit but no candy or soda, please and thank you.
- A **small (6" X8")** pencil box or other type of plastic container with pencils, crayons (24 maximum) glue stick, magic markers, scissors (labeled), erasers, "dry erase" marker (for a student white board) that will remain in school.
- A "dry erase" eraser that will remain in school.
- A Three ring binder (Maximum size is 1 inch or 1 ½ inches deep ) that will be used to keep work, poetry, songs, etc.
- A 1 subject note book.
- A small eight or twelve ounce bottle of water - please don't send in large water bottles as they get tipped over. (Imagine the mess!) This will come home to you nightly to be washed, refilled, and returned the next day.

### Supplies for the classroom

The class is grateful for any donations. If at all possible please send in the following items during the first month of school. These will be shared with all the children.

- Box of tissues (Puff's or Puff's Plus once cold season hits) to share with the class
- Container of Clorox wipes or Lysol wipes labeled with child's name

- Paper towels
- Gallon, quart size and Sandwich size zip log bags (choose one to send in)
