1 Purpose

- 1.1 The purpose of this policy is to establish criteria for the administration of the health program followed by the Benjamin Franklin Classical Charter Public School (BFCCPS) in adherence to our school charter.

2 Scope

- 2.1 All members of the BFCCPS community.

3 Responsibility

- 3.1 The BFCCPS BOT is responsible for interpreting the provisions of this policy.
- 3.2 The Head of School is responsible for the implementation and adherence of the provisions of this policy.

5 Procedures

- 5.1 The school will appoint and provide students access to at least one physician and registered nurse.
- 5.2 The school will collaborate with the health director in the district school system.
- 5.3 The school will provide health services in a manner consistent with:
 - 5.3.1 Charter School Administrative and Governance Guide
 - 5.3.2 Massachusetts Department of Public Health (DPH) statutes and regulations
 - 5.3.3 Massachusetts general laws and regulations
- 5.4 The school will maintain written documentation of compliance with applicable laws and regulations including evidence of compliance with any required insurance coverage.
